Partnership Agreement between German Church School in Addis Ababa/Ethiopia and Friedrich-Ebert-Gymnasium in Sandhausen/Germany

The partnership program between the German Church School in Addis Ababa and the Friedrich-Ebert-Gymnasium Sandhausen was initiated in 2006 and it has been successfully developed since then. People in charge of the program are Ato Yohannes Derbew and Ato Merdassa Kassaye on part of the German Church School and Barbara Reske and Markus Wild on the part of Friedrich-Ebert-Gymnasium Sandhausen.

The program basically includes three equally important parts:

- 1. Partner students from both schools get to know each other and experience their mutual cultures and interests in meetings, discussions and excursions
- 2. Placement program (Sozialpraktikum Jahrgangsstufe 1 am Friedrich-Ebert-Gymnasium) for German students in various social institutions and NGOs in Addis Ababa
- 3. Educational visits to various institutions (e.g. social, political) in Addis Ababa and excursions to places in Ethiopia (partners from both sides or Germans only)

The program of each year's meeting is jointly organized in advance by teachers of both schools and/or social workers on the part of the German Church School.

The German Church is the competent institution of the German Church School. The respective pastor benevolently supports the program.
